Since opening the first of our Hertfordshire restaurants in 2004, we've sought to place our restaurants at the very heart of the communities in which they're situated - in every sense. As a local business we respect our responsibility to play an active role in our neighbourhood.

What does that really mean?

It means that our restaurants aren't simply places for people to come and enjoy a meal in exchange for a cash.

Over the last few years, we've contributed more than £50,000 to local good causes and supported charities to support people who are homeless, feed people struggling put food on the table and children who would otherwise miss out on breakfast.

Each month we donate two sets of £50 meal vouchers to a local charity or good cause.

We also host a charity dinner each year at which we raise in the region of £10,000 for a single good cause.

Additionally, we offer all of our restaurants for free as venues for others, including the local mayor, to host fundraising events.
